### Verulam - 15th September

The team made the long trip down to Hemel Hempstead for our 1<sup>st</sup> Gala of the season. This was an unusual event as race winners received 1 point and 6 points for last place. We got off to an excellent start with wins for Marcus Eaton (u14 50m Back), Leo Clarkson (u16 100m Breaststroke), and Matt Houghton (u14 50m Free) along with the Boys u12 Freestyle relay to give us a 12 point lead after the first 14 events.

The next 14 events brought another 3 1<sup>st</sup> places, for Ally Sloan (u12 50m Fly), Ashlee Ward (open 100m Breaststroke) and for the Boys u14 Medley Relay. By this time we had extended the lead to 19 points. The last 21 events saw us achieve 4 more 1<sup>st</sup> places, David Clarkson (u14 50m Breaststroke), Boys u16 Medley Relay, Boys u12 Medley Relay and the Boys u14 Freestyle relay. Along side these 1<sup>st</sup> places we also had eighteen 2<sup>nd</sup> and eleven 3<sup>rd</sup> places, this meant that we were in the top 3 for 40 of the 49 events.

The final results saw us coming 1<sup>st</sup> out of the 6 teams that entered with 122 points, 27 points ahead of Enfield who came second.

Swim of the night must go to Nicola Kenton for knocking a massive 13 seconds off her 100m fly time. All of the team took part with enthusiasm and purpose, this was exemplified by the look of sheer determination on Leo Clarkson's face as he pushed for the finish to win his race.

Overall this was an excellent result with many of the team swimming up an age group or two! with 21 PB's broken.

### Milton Keynes - 1st December

This was a 'B' grade gala with no cut off times, so it was always going to be one of our toughest galas this year. However the results show that all the hard work that the team puts into training is starting to pay off.

There were wins for Andrew Ward (12/U 50m Backstroke & 50m Butterfly), David Clarkson (12/u 50m Breaststroke), Sam Henmam (14/u 50m Breaststroke) and James Buckle (Open 50m Freestyle & 50m Backstroke). There was also a first place for the Mixed 12/u Medley Relay team (Andrew Ward, David Clarkson, Stevie Brett and Sophie Aitken). The evening saw the team set 14 PB's and 9 club records, not bad going for 16 swimmers!

### Autumn Trophy - 6th October

We went to Wellingborough with high expectations of retaining this trophy. Despite some strong opposition from Wellingborough, once again the team came up trumps!

The evening went extremely well with Ally Sloan (13/U Fly), Bethany Saunders (13/u Fly) and Shannon O'Dell (15/u Back) all setting club records. We also had a win with William Wing in the 13/u Fly. There were more wins for Louis Saunders, Rhys O'Dell, Georgina Kenton and Shaan Patel but because they were faster than the cut off time we didn't get any points. The 11/u boys won both the Freestyle and Medley relays, as did the boys 13/u team. Not to be out done the girls 15/u team managed the same feat! We had more relay success with the 11/u girls medley relay.

The final result was Rushden 194, Wellingborough 182, Witney 145, Kettering 139, Modernians 113 and Deepings 100

### St Neots - 13th October

This was the first time the club had taken part in a gala that included 200m and 400m events. Unfortunately we had to sit out the first 4 events as we had no swimmers, but then they were 200m butterfly races!

Considering that this was the first time our swimmers had competed at these distance we did extremely well. The night saw eight 1st places, 26 PB's and 17 club records out of the 18 swimmers that took part. The final placings were Huntingdon 82, St Neots 75 and Rushden 54

We will definitely be back next year and I'm sure will have some 200m butterfly swimmers as well.

### Sheffield - 24th November

This year we took a team of 23 swimmers to Pond's Forge. For many this was their first experience of swimming in a 50m international competition pool. We came home with 9 trophies and 1 speeding ticket. The team also came 11th out of the 37 clubs who entered. It was a superb effort from everyone who took part.
